Dear Parent / Guardian

Our school has been working with Living Streets and Transport for Greater Manchester (TfGM) to encourage more families to walk all or part of their journey to school.

Our Eco Warriors have been finding out more about the issues and have surveyed parents to understand their views. Many parents are concerned about road safety around the school and said that they would consider park and stride - parking further from school and walking the last part of their journey.

We are asking families to join our **Parking Promise**, to reduce the number of cars around our school and make the environment safer, less congested and more pleasant for our children and local community:



- Our family promise to walk, scoot or cycle to school whenever we can.**
- Our family promise to 'park and stride' if we need to use our car.**
- Our family promise to park outside of the red zone marked on the map (over the page).**
- Our family promise to park with consideration for local residents and never block people's driveways.**
- Our family promise to drive slowly (less than 20mph) and carefully through Springfield Road.**
- Our family promise not to park on the pavements or grass verges.**
- Our family promise to support children in learning road safety skills on the journey to school, leading by example.**
